DRIP PAINTING

Drip painting is a form of abstract art in which paint is dripped or poured on to the canvas.

This style of action painting was first experimented with, in the first half of the twentieth century.

You can dip a thick, long-haired brush deep into the paint and swing it on your canvas, but you can also pierce a hole in the bottom of a paint pot so the paint slowly runs out ...

By swinging the paint pot back and forth
on a rope above the lying cloth,
all kinds of erratic lines, curves and splashes are created.
