

# PLASTER WATER

PLASTER SUCKS WATER LIKE A SPONGE.  
SO DOES IT ALSO ABSORB A LOT OF POWERTEX LIQUID.

BEST IS TO MOIST THE PLASTER FIRST WITH A WET BRUSH  
BEFORE YOU APPLY POWERTEX UNIVERSAL MEDIUM ONTO IT

OR YOU ADD ONLY A FEW DROPS OF WATER  
TO DILUTE YOUR FIRST LAYER OF POWERTEX LIQUID PAINT A BIT  
TO APPLY AS THE FIRST COLORING LAYER.



✓ PROCEEDING AS ABOVE, ITHER WAY, WILL  
ALSO AVOID YOU WILL GET IRREGULAR COLORING STAINTS.

➔ BEFORE YOU APPLY A SECOND LAYER OF COVERING  
PAINT, POWERTEX, EASY VARNISH, ...  
MAKE SURE THOUGH THE PLASTER IS MEANWHILE AGAIN FULLY DRY  
OTHERWISE YOU WILL RISK BLATTERING AFTER A WHILE  
SINCE THE WATER/MOIST INSIDE DID NOT EVAPORATE.
