BEST IS TO MOIST THE PLASTER FIRST WITH A WET BRUSH BEFORE YOU APPLY POWERTEX UNIVERSAL MEDIUM ONTO IT

OR YOU ADD ONLY A FEW DROPS OF WATER
TO DILUTE YOUR FIRST LAYER OF POWERTEX LIQUID PAINT A BIT
TO APPLY AS THE FIRST COLORING LAYER.

PROCEEDING AS ABOVE, ITHER WAY, WILL ALSO AVOID YOU WILL GET IRREGULAR COLORING STAINTS.

PAINT, POWERTEX, EASY VARNISH, ...

MAKE SURE THOUGH THE PLASTER IS MEANWHILE AGAIN FULLY DRY

OTHERWISE YOU WILL RISK BLATTERING AFTER A WHILE

SINCE THE WATER/MOIST INSIDE DID NOT EVAPORATE.
